ORDER FOR CHANGE OF VENUE FOR IMPROPER VENUE

- Defendant has filed a motion and affidavit for change of venue per A.R.S. 12-404A & JCRCP 133.
- The plaintiff did not dispute defendant's affidavit within the time allowed.
- The plaintiff has disputed defendant's affidavit and has filed a Certificate supporting the venue choice.

The Court, having considered what has been submitted by the parties:

- Finds that plaintiff's choice of venue was not improper, that either the defendant resides in this precinct, or the cause of action occurred in this precinct, or other statutory exceptions apply. Defendant is not entitled to a change of venue.
- Finds that plaintiff's choice of venue was not improper, however, for good cause orders that this action be transferred to _____ without assessment of costs to plaintiff.
- Finds that plaintiff's choice of venue is improper. Defendant's motion for change of venue is granted.
