1. This inspection is conducted under the authority of Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) Title 49, Chapter 1, Article 1, §§ 49-106 and 49-107, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality/Pinal County Delegation Agreement No. 06-0028, and Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) Title 18, Chapter 9, Articles 1 and 3 (Aquifer Protection Permits); Title 18, Chapter 13, Article 3 (Refuse and Other Objectionable Wastes); Title 18, Chapter 13, Article 11 (Collection, Transportation, and Disposal of Human Excreta); Pinal County Sanitary Code, Chapter 10 (On-site Wastewater Treatment Facilities).
2. The purpose of this inspection is to assess compliance of your facility with the above-listed administrative rules and regulations as they pertain to the issuance of a license or compliance with licensure requirements.

6. Each person who has a conversation with the County inspector during the inspection that is tape recorded will be informed that the conversation is being tape recorded.
7. Each person interviewed will be informed that statements made by the person may be included in the inspection report.

Your due process rights relating to an appeal of a final decision of a County based on the results of the inspection are found at A.R.S. §§ 41-1061 to 41-1066 and Pinal County Sanitary Code, Chapter 10, Section 10.09. Your rights relating to an appeal of a final County decision are found in A.R.S. § 12-901, *et seq.* A county decision pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-1603 E and F is not an appealable county action.
