

A Permit is required for non-mine related blasting in Pinal County. Blasting is regulated under the 2018 International Fire Code, Chapter 56 and as amended by the Pinal County Building Code Ordinance. Permits are required a minimum of five days in advance of any blasting. In order to apply for a permit, please call for an appointment at (520) 866-6442.

As a minimum, you will be required to submit the following:

- A narrative explaining the specifics of where and how you intend to blast. This should include the proposed land use.
- A site plan showing where the proposed blast will occur.
- A copy of your Federal Explosives User Permit or License.
- A copy of your license issued by the State of Arizona Registrar of Contractors.
- Proof of a valid certificate of insurance.
- A plan for notification of applicable agencies and/or residents.
- \$84.00 permit fee. A dust permit and associated fees may also be required.
- Any other information as may be required by the County.
